Guidelines

- On October 7th: Artists must paint one piece of art depicting a scene from <u>Chesterfield Township or North Crosswicks</u>, and submit that painting for judging. (Historic Walnford is <u>not</u> included for Plein Air painting on the 7th).
- The artist may submit up to 5 additional paintings for the exhibition and reception on the evening of October 7th.
- Additional submissions should showcase architecture, streetscapes and/or landscapes of New Jersey.
- 30% of the sale price of all sold art pieces is donated to the Chesterfield Township Historical Society.
- Artists must have their canvas or paper stamped at designated times either on the day before the Plein Air or the morning of the event.
- Artwork must be two-dimensional.
- New: Maximum CANVAS entry size is 16" x 20", this does NOT include mat and frame. All entries must follow framing requirements listed just below.
- Framing requirements: All submitted artwork must be framed and ready to hang; wire hanging only (no saw tooth); hanging wire should be slightly taut; screw eyes should be placed 1/3 from the top of the frame; and for unframed canvas paintings, the sides must be a continuation of the painting.
- Artists must provide their own supplies and equipment, including art supplies, matts, frames and hanging wire.
- Artwork remains on display in the gallery on October 7th until 8:00pm: end of reception.

Liability

The Chesterfield Township Historical Society will make every effort to protect all submitted artwork from damage or loss, but the society cannot be held liable for any damage or loss of artwork submitted for judging. The Chesterfield Township Historical Society reserves the right to publish for publicity reproductions of the entries.
